## **Visitor Computer Internet Filtering Policy and Procedures**

*Revised September 5, 2008*

### **Policy**

The Yavapai College Library makes a limited number of computers available to county residents and visitors who are not students of the College (hereafter identified as “visitors”). In order to comply with Arizona Statute 34-502 (Computer Access; harmful to minors), the Library will provide filtered Internet access to any visitor who cannot show proof that s/he is at least the age of 18 or logs in using a temporary GuestID. Unfiltered access to the Internet is available to a registered Library patron who can show legitimate proof of being 18 years of age or older. Wireless access to the Internet is unfiltered and only available to visitors age 18 and above.

The Library supports intellectual freedom. In cases where a legitimate research site is blocked, Library staff may at their discretion unblock such a site for the research purposes of a minor.

All visitors using computers at the Yavapai College Library must acknowledge and abide by the Yavapai College Acceptable Use Statement. Visitors are not allowed to share their account. Failure to abide by these rules may result in revocation of Library privileges.
