FY24-25 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Center for Learning and Innovation - Prescott Campus (CLI-P)

Framing and electrical rough-in continue for the first and second floors, with wire being pulled through the newly installed conduit. Fire sprinkler installation has begun, along with the painting of structural steel and above-ceiling steel. The framing of the new YCF offices and the access corridor from the existing YCF office suite are complete.

Drywall installation begins the week of November 11 and will continue through December.




FIRST FLOOR

SECOND FLOOR PLAN










MICTED/YC Culinary Prescott Campus

The College is partnering with MICTED to renovate Building 4, Room 220, to transform this space from a science lab into a culinary lab.


Construction activity has increased with the completion of demolition and installation of gas and electrical services. Plumbing rough-in is underway along with the framing of new workstations. The equipment list has been submitted and electrical/gas requirements are being determined.

There will continue to be a need to access mechanical and plumbing from spaces below room 220 through the first week of November, so stay tuned for future Newsflashes regarding temporary construction detours. Most work is being completed off hours.

BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS PLANNED MAINTENANCE PROJECTS

As part of the budget, planned maintenance projects are scheduled each year to ensure that College facilities are maintained at a level to support optimum performance in building systems and infrastructure, life safety compliance, adequate maintenance and repair of roadways, parking lots, and College grounds. These projects result from a recent Facilities Condition Assessment (FCA), which identifies when repairs, modifications, or replacement of components should occur.

FCA Projects:

PAC stucco replacement – through November 2024

Bldg. 3 Storefront window and door replacement—expected completion in December 2024 Bldg. 3 Kitchen floor — expected completion in January 2025

Buildings 3 & 4 Deck surfacing – expected completion summer of 2025.
