



# Application process for Accredited Yavapai College Paramedic Program



Program Goal: "To prepare Paramedics who are competent in the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains to enter the profession."

- 1. Students MUST apply and be admitted to Yavapai College. To become a Yavapai College student, apply at <u>www.yc.edu/become</u>.
- 2. Admittance to the Paramedic program is by application only. To be eligible to apply for this paramedic program, you must currently be certified as an EMT through the NREMT or AZ state.
- 3. The program is two semesters, with a minimum of 1,000 didactic, clinical, and agency ride hours.
- 4. Class days are Tuesdays and Thursdays from 0800-1800
- 5. Applications MUST be received no later than March 15<sup>th,</sup> 2025, at 1700
- 6. Only **complete** applications will be considered.
- Applications received <u>after</u> the submission deadline will automatically be placed on a waitlist.
- 8. All Paramedic Students must take and pass a 10-panel drug screen and background check. This will be completed during admission to the program.
- 9. Once the applications are reviewed, candidates will be emailed about the next steps.

# **Submission Checklist**

Submit the full and completed application by the <u>due date</u>. Email a copy of all the required records listed below with your application.

- Two-dose series MMR
- Two dose series varicella
- **Negative TB skin test or chest x-ray** (*Must be within 6 months of clinical start date*)
- **Tdap Vaccination-** (*Must be within 10 years of clinical start date*)
- Hep B three-dose series or two-dose series (or a YC exemption)
- **Current Flu shot** (or a YC exemption, which will be provided at Orientation)
- **Covid 19 Vaccine card** (or YC exemption, which will be provided at Orientation)
- Current State EMT card
- Current BLS provider card
- o Government ID
- Copy of Current Health Insurance
- Accuplacer Reading Exam (Candidates must schedule an <u>Accuplacer reading</u> <u>exam</u> with the YC testing center. This may be scheduled at the Prescott Testing Center (928)776-2200 or Verde Valley Testing Center (928)634-6561.
  Please call the testing center to schedule. Once completed, you must send in a copy of your score. A Minimum Passing Score of 236 or higher is required.)
