Agenda and Key Discussion Points

1. College Council Update (Julie Galgano)

- New College Council Sub-Committee: Dr. Berry introduced a new sub-committee focused on faculty-led studies and curriculum.
- Academic Master Plan Committee (AMP):
 - Goals include the Integrated Program Evaluation System (PES).
 - Provides annual reviews and recommendations to the Executive Leadership Team (ELT).
 - Meghan Paquette (absent) will serve as liaison and attend future meetings

2. SLOA (Student Learning Outcomes Assessment) (Sarah Southwick)

- Assessment Day is tentatively scheduled for September 12 or 19.
- A sub-committee is being formed to review assessment reports and curriculum maps.

3. Curriculum Committee Update (Emily Peek)

- Three-Year BS in Applied Business: Approved by the committee.
- 205 Curriculum Proposals: Received and awaiting more submissions.
- **New AGEC Structure**: Planned for the 2025-26 academic year, affecting general education categories.
- Three vs. Four-Year Programs: Three-year (92-credit) option has no elective block and removed concentrations, which should not affect Master's program transfers.

4. Policy Review Update (Leslie Sparkman)

- Reviewed policies on instructor absences; feedback requested.
- Approved Policies:
 - ITS, Cash-Out, Clean Desk/Clear Screen, Student Learning Evaluation, Probation Period for Staff/Faculty.
- Vote: No changes recommended for the "Instructors as Students" policy; sent back to College Council.

5. Strategic Committee (Ginney Bilbray absent; update by Julie Galgano)

- Holiday Food Drive: Accepting donations to reach \$2,000 goal. Current total: \$835.
- Angel Tree Toy Drive: Set up at Buildings 1 and I (Verde). YC students in need can request support.
- Winter Celebration Party:
 - Prescott: December 17
 - o Verde: December 4
 - RSVP required; buffet will be provided at Prescott and held at Strada in Verde

6. Executive Leadership Team (ELT) Update (Janet Nix)

- Vacation Cash-Out Policy: Passed with reminders:
 - Cash-out amount is taxed.
 - Maximum: 88 hours for those with <5 years of service; 128 hours for those with >5 years.
 - Must maintain a 40-hour balance at all times.
 - Reguests due by December 31, with no reversals.
- Bellwether Awards: YC recognized as a Top 10 finalist for College Council initiatives.
