Fall Emerging Artist Exhibition

The Yavapai College Prescott Art Gallery presents the juried Fall Emerging Artist Exhibition. The exhibition provides YC students with the opportunity to experience the submission and jury process and to present their artwork in a professional Fine Art Gallery, while receiving recognition for their accomplishments from professionals in the field.

The **Robert Hauber Prize** of \$500.00 will be awarded to one of the outstanding selected artworks in the juried Fall Emerging Artist Exhibition. All awards will be presented at the Yavapai College Prescott Art Gallery Opening Reception on Friday, Nov 16, 2018.

Eligibility

Students currently enrolled in for-credit courses at YC may submit up to two entries for consideration. Original artwork created in the Art Department **for-credit classes** during the Spring 2018, Summer 2018, or Fall 2018 may be submitted. Artwork previously submitted but not exhibited may be resubmitted.

* Two Dimensional artwork needs to be photographed unframed and you will need to bring a thumb drive to save images.

Save images in JPG format, 300 dpi and no larger than 2MB, with the correct orientation, spelling and capitalization in the titles.

One submission can include two photos: **Title Image:** LastName_FirstName_Title

Before you Submit

Be prepared and know the Title, Media, Dimensions, Category of Entry, Retail Price or if Not for Sale include the Insurance Value. Yavapai College Art Gallery retains 25% commission of all sold artworks.

Submit up to two entries. Each artwork is one submission.

One submission can include two photos:

Detail Image: (close up image) LastName_FirstName_Title_Detail

Submit

Log onto www.yc.edu/artgallery

Locate and click onto the submission button for **Prescott - Fall Emerging Artist Exhibition**

- Register using your YC student email and password, continue following the directions.
- List the dimensions of 2-D work; height and length, and 3-D; height, length and width. Make a note in submittable, if 3-D artwork will need to be hung on the wall, which must not exceed 35lbs.
- Double check your contact information, if you enter the wrong email, you will not be notified.

Reminder: LOG OUT after submission - Otherwise your contact email will be connected to other entries.

Once You've Been Accepted

Complete and have your instructor sign the Registration Form (page 4), and deliver along with the “exhibit ready” artwork to the Prescott Art Gallery on Sat, Nov 10, 10 am - 3 pm.

- All 3D artwork must be ready to install with a finished presentation, including felt or smooth surfaces that come in contact with pedestal surfaces. Wall artwork should not exceed 35 lbs.
- All 2D artwork must be framed and ready-to-hang. The hanging wire measures 2” below the top of frame when taut. All other hanging devices will be rejected upon registration. Wall artwork should not exceed 35lbs.
- Each artwork must fit through the gallery doors. If artwork is too heavy for gallery staff to lift, you will be asked for assistance to help install.
- Artwork on paper, including photography, must be framed and have Plexiglass or glass protection, and “ready-to-hang” with wire only.
- Artwork on canvas must be framed or the canvas must be gallery wrapped for a finished presentation.
- Deliver an Artist Statement to the Art Gallery prior to the date of the Opening Reception.
- All artwork selected for the exhibition may be photographed by the college for publication or educational purposes. The YC Art Gallery retains 25% commission on all sold artwork.

Juror Kimanne Lee Core

Kimanne has had a successful career stemming from her education from Miami University, Oxford, Ohio with a B.F.A. and an M.F.A. from William Paterson University in Wayne, NJ. She has freelanced as an editorial illustrator in New York City, a book jacket illustrator for children’s books, magazines and newspapers. Publishers include Doubleday, The New York Times, Simon & Schuster, McGraw-Hill, Houghton Mifflin, London Records, and Parents Magazine. In 2006 Kimanne had the honor of being selected into the National Portrait Gallery in Washington D.C. with her painting titled “Nala.” Currently Kimanne Lee Core is teaching art at the New Canaan High School, Connecticut and also in her 12th year as an Advanced Placement Studio Art Reader.
