A Note from the Nursing Program Director

Welcome nursing students to the Spring 2021 semester. Currently there are approximately 193 enrolled nursing program students. There are program nursing students at Prescott and Verde Valley locations, including a new cohort of 50 first semester students! Yavapai College (YC) Nursing graduates continue to be successful on the Arizona NCLEX-RN Licensure with an annual pass rate of 87% for 2020*; and an AZBN pass rate average of 91%.

Currently, according to Arizona Board of Nursing there are 96,815 RN's practicing in Arizona. An increased demand for RNs in Arizona's future to be 28,000 more needed by 2025*. Job Placement Rates for graduates in 2019* is 87%

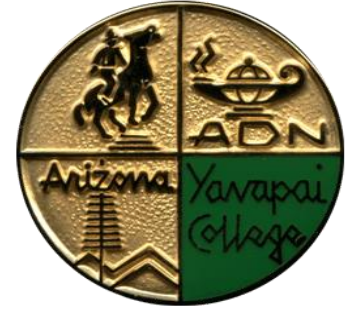

If the actual expiration date of your CPR or TB is after the semester end date, but you have a prompt on Castle Branch to renew before semester start, then please contact me so an override to the expiration date can be requested.

If your expiration date needs to be re-set to allow you to upload an early renewal of your CPR certification or TB test results, please choose one of the following methods for contact:

Castle Branch customer service at 1-888-666-7788 (choose option 1 and follow prompts). *If a hold time extends past your availability, use the option to request a call back. Representatives do not leave for the day until every number is called back.*

Submit a web inquiry on your account – log in to account, click orange **Need Help?** button in the upper right-hand corner and click **Submit Support Inquiry**

For all early renewal requests, please use a phrase such as ***“I need to update my (TB, CPR) information; can you populate my renewal early?”***

A new renewal date request will take 24-72 hours to be completed in the Castle Branch system. Please plan accordingly.

Flu immunizations for the 2020-2021 flu season should already be complete on your Castle Branch account. **Students with Castle Branch accounts that are overdue for the flu immunization need to correct the issue within week one of the semester- January 19-23. Failure to do so may result in administrative withdrawal from the program-** refer to the Nursing Program Student Handbook.

Make sure to check all your requirements to verify all documentation is approved and current through the semester including Tdap and Fingerprint Clearance Card. Your current Castle Branch **“To Do List Summary”** report indicating Nursing Program **Compliance** may be requested at any time throughout the program.

We are excited to announce we are implementing another multilevel simulation experience for Spring 2021 semester for students who missed a clinical day; the date is yet to be determined but will be held in the Simulation Lab for students who missed clinical. The feedback from students who attended the Fall 2020 multilevel simulation was overwhelmingly positive, and promoted a sense of collegiality and pride for those in attendance.

The simulation committee has a simulation policy for both students and faculty that has clearly defined expectations and objectives for simulation experiences. All students will receive an electronic copy in addition to the Nursing Program Student Handbook. The faculty have chosen Zigmont's 3D Model of Debriefing as the guide to help deepen the experience of simulation for students and to help foster a safe learning environment. ATI Integration

ATI Nursing Educational Resources are used throughout the Nursing Program, in every semester and is required for all nursing program students.

Students have a wealth of resources to support and supplement their learning through utilization of the ATI Resources.

Students purchase the online materials and resources through ATI 1-800-367-4762. The materials are financial aid-able. Students are required to purchase their ATI materials in order to maintain enrollment in their nursing program courses. Students that have not purchased their materials within the second week of the course start date will not be permitted to progress in the course.

ATI will provide the access code directly to the student.

Students should direct ATI Resource questions to their course/clinical Nursing Instructor; the Nursing Instructor will be very helpful. The fee amount will be specific to the semester of the nursing program student.
